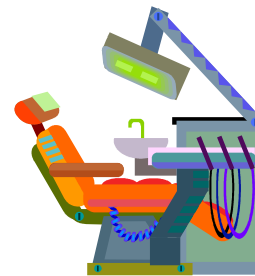


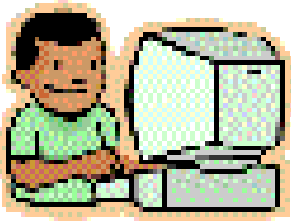


Digital technology plays an increasing part in daily life.

- * at the post office



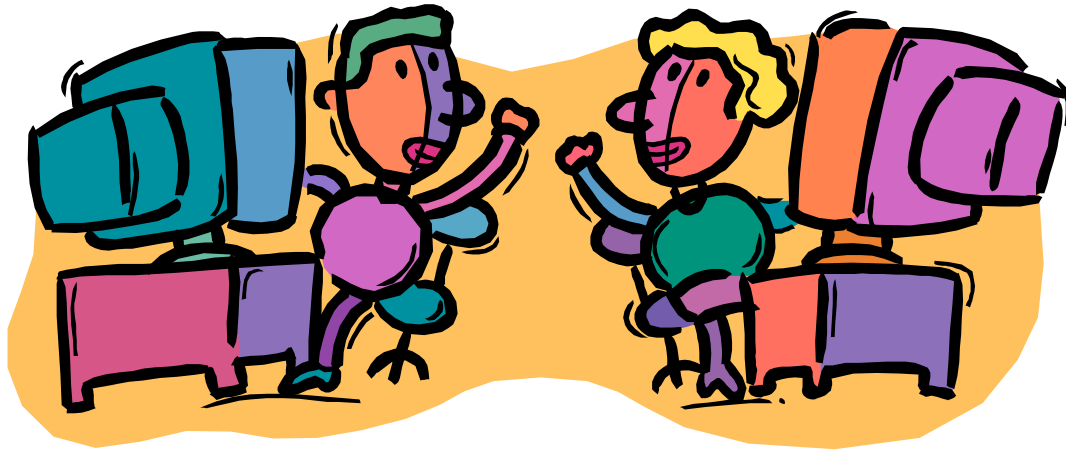


What do children Learn from digital technology?

Using digital technology can help your child to:

- * develop hand eye/eye coordination
- * concentrate for longer periods of time
- * improve listening skills
- * follow instructions
- * develop mouse and keyboard skills
- * develop position, movement and direction skills
- * feel a sense of achievement





Children develop their digital technology skills through a variety of programmes especially designed for pre-school children.

Many of the programmes available are designed to develop pre-number and pre-reading skills. This is what we often use our smartboards for.

Other programmes provide opportunities for colour recognition, sequencing, following favourite nursery rhymes and colour and shape matching.
